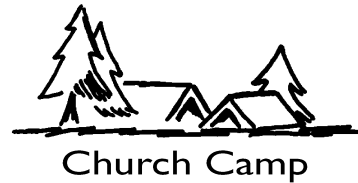


Church Newsletter Articles
