

# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please be aware of the registration process for camps! Campers will receive an "Early Bird" discounted rate on camp registration forms postmarked by May 15.

**After May 15**, campers will be admitted if there is space and adequate staff.

This fee arrangement is designed to encourage early registration of our campers. This will allow for better overall planning for our summer program.

Everyone must pre-register. **"Walk-ins" will NOT be accepted.** It is expected that all participants will stay for the entire length of the camp for which they are registered. Total fees less \$10.00 will be refunded if cancellation is made 2 weeks prior to the first day of camp. Total fees less \$25.00 will be refunded if cancellation is made less than 2 weeks prior to camp. **No refunds on mission camps.**

**Consult** your local camping coordinator for the necessary steps in sending in your camp fees. Registration/Health forms are available from your pastor OR you can download the forms from our web page, <http://www.indianadisciples.org>. **Send in your registration/health form along with your full payment to the Regional Office. Make check payable, include registration/health form, and mail to Christian Church in Indiana.** Your registration will be acknowledged shortly. You will receive an email giving you details of your camp, a confirmation of your registration, a map, and a list of things to bring to camp.

**No camper is admitted without registration/health form and payment.**

**Insurance** carried by camper's family is to be "first line" of coverage. The region carries insurance to assist as needed as "second line."
